FAQs

1. Which Internet browser works best with OAG DOT Analyser?

We recommend customers use Google Chrome.

2. How up to date is the data in DOT Analyser?

The OAG DOT Analyser home screen has a box labelled Data Overview which when you open it displays the date of the most recent database update for each DOT report. This is also available in each report.

3. Why do the tables in DOT Analyser have letters and numbers at the start?

Each of the tables in DOT Analyser uses data from a correlating table produced by the US Department of Transportation. The labels given to each table are those used by the US Department of Transportation.

4. Where can I get more information about the data in each of the tables?

The data in DOT Analyser comes from the US Department of Transportation Bureau of Transportation Statistics. More information about all the tables can be found on their website www.transtats.bts.gov. A list of terms used is available in the DOT Analyser User Guide with some definitions in the DOT Analyser Glossary but for complete definitions of the metrics refer to the Department of Transportation.

5. Do I need to select an option or enter a selection in every box in the query screen?

No. the selections you make are simply ways to narrow down the data to meet your requirements. However, we do recommend that you make your query as specific as possible in DOT Analyser as large queries may take a long time to process.
